

- **Watercolours:** Tube or pan - a **good quality student** brand (such as Cotman) or **artist quality**. Quality is so important for good results as the pigment ratio is higher. I prefer tubes - it's easier to create larger puddles of paint.
It's fine to bring whatever colours you have. I've created a list below if you would like to add colours to your supplies.
- **Brushes:** A selection of round and flat synthetic or synthetic mix watercolour brushes. A medium mop or Hake is useful for large areas. (See images below)
- **Paper** - A good quality paper is crucial for how it receives the paint. Bring plenty of cold pressed (not watercolour paper, 300gsm, (approx. A3 or A4 size). Laura will have extra watercolour paper for you to buy for 50p per sheet. Glued pads are easy to work with (blocks or spirals less so).

- **Watercolour palette**
- **Kitchen roll**
- **Hairdryer**
- **Blue masking tape** (regular masking tape can damage your paper)
- **Board** for taping your paper onto
- **Water Jars** - 2 large sized
- **Apron**
- **Sponge and old toothbrush** for texture and spattering
- **Misc. drawing materials** - HB pencil, white eraser, pen (for tracing down) sketchbook, etc.
- **Optional: Masking fluid, an old or masking brush, fairy liquid** (to protect the bush)

If you are new to watercolour and would like to borrow materials, Laura can provide paints, brushes and paper for an extra fee of £7.00, payable to her in cash on the day.
