

Wildflowers Watercolour Workshop - Materials List

Materials To Bring:

- Watercolours (see list below)
- Brushes (see below)
- Watercolour palette
- Plenty of good quality watercolour paper, Cold pressed (not), 300gsm/140 lb. (I will have extra watercolour paper for you to buy for 50p per sheet)
- Kitchen roll
- 2 large sized water jars
- Misc. drawing materials: pencil, kneaded or white rubber, sketchbook.

Basic Flower Painters Palette:

- Cadmium Yellow (or pale), or Hansa Yellow light
- Cadmium Yellow medium
- Cadmium Orange or Winsor Yellow Deep
- Scarlet Lake or Pyrrole Red
- Permanent Rose
- Quinacridone or Permanent Magenta
- Permanent Mauve or Dioxazine Violet
- Cobalt Blue
- Cerulean or Manganese Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Hookers or Sap Green

if you don't have all these colours it's okay - just bring what you have!

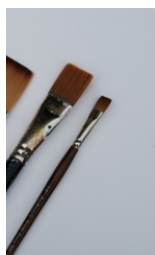
Pan and tube sets will have these or similar colours. Tubes are easier for mixing larger puddles of paint. I recommend you work with an artist quality or a good brand. You will get better results and it's more economical in the end (I use QoR watercolours).
